

DECISION N° **8210490** /MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC/SE OF **05 NOV 2021**

Lunch a competitive entrance examination into the first year of Sciences and Technics of Biological Agriculture programs for the Ebolowa site of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundere, for the 2021/2022 academic year.

- Mindful Considering the decree no. 2012/333 of June 29, 2012, to appoint a Vice-Chancellor and Rectors in some State Universities;
- Mindful Considering the decree no. 2012/366 of August 06, 2012, to appoint staff to posts of responsibility in State Universities;
- Mindful Considering the decree no. 2017/318 of June 27, 2017, to appoint staff to posts of responsibility in State Universities;
- Mindful Considering the resolutions and recommendations of the 45th session of the University Council. The Board of Administration of the University of Ngaoundéré, in its 46th ordinary session, adopts the resolutions and recommendations of the 45th session of the University Council, held on 29 September 2021;
- Mindful Considering the resolution no. 005/2021/UN/PCA/R of the 46th ordinary session of the Council of the University of Ngaoundéré approving the opening of the Department of the Science and Technics of Biological Agriculture
Following the proposal of the Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré,

DECIDE:

ARTICLE 1:

A competitive entrance examination for the admission of **40 students** into the first year of the Sciences and Technics of Biological Agriculture programs for the Ebolowa site of the Faculty of Science of the

University of Ngaoundere is open on **16 January 2022** for the academic year 2021/2022. Candidates will sit for the exam in **Ngaoundere, Yaounde and Ebolowa**.

The places offered are distributed as follows:

Study Program	Specialty	Total number of places
Animal products	Animal products	20
Vegetal products	Vegetal products	20

Candidates for the 1st year entrance examination must be not be more than twenty-five (25) years old on 1 January 2022.

ARTICLE 2:

(1) The competitive entrance examination is opened to Cameroonians of both sexes, holders of *Baccalauréat série C* and *D* or the General Certificate of Education Examination, Advanced level (GCE 'A' Level) in at least three science subjects and GCE 'O' level, or any other equivalent certificate recognized by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education. The subject "Religious Knowledge" is not considered.

(2) Members of the Central African Economic and Monetary Community (CEMAC) who have ratified the text concerning the national treatment of students will also be admitted under the same conditions like those of Cameroonians.

ARTICLE 3:

The complete application files must reach the Service de la Scolarité of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundéré, the UN Branch in Yaoundé (Fouda district), "Lycée Classique et Moderne" of Ebolowa, before **January 10, 2022**. They should include the following documents:

1. A registration form available on the MINESUP website: www.minesup.gov.cm, at the office of admission and record of the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Ngaoundéré, at the Branch of the UN of Yaoundé (Fouda district) and at "Lycée Classique et Moderne" d'Ebolowa ;
2. A receipt of payment of the sum of 20,000 (twenty thousand) CFA Francs for registration fees to the competition at "Société Générale Cameroun" to account n° 10003 00900 22091073445 19 FS Ngaoundéré;
3. Certified photocopies of the scientific Baccalaureate or a scientific GCE/AL or any certified attestation copy of success to one of these examinations;
4. Certified photocopies of the scientific GCE 'A' level or scientific *Baccalaureate* and GCE 'O' level or *Probatoire scientifique* transcripts;
5. A certified photocopy of birth certificate of not more than 03 months old;
6. A medical report of physical and mental fitness, testifying that the candidate is apt for higher education studies, issued by a medical doctor of the public administration;
7. Five 4x4 photographs, with the names of the candidate at the back;
8. A stamp envelop with the personal address of the candidate.

NB: Candidates who have submitted their application, subject to the scientific Baccalaureate or the GCE A/Level will only be admitted to the entrance examination after presentation of proof of their admission to the above diploma (signed result slip, transcript, ...).

ARTICLE 4:

The registration fees are nonrefundable.

ARTICLE 5:

Only candidates with complete application files would be allowed to compete for admission into the study programs.

ARTICLE 6:

- (1) The competitive examination is made up of:
- evaluation of academic profile (coefficient 2, thus 30% of the total mark)
 - written examination (coefficient 5, thus 70% of the total mark)
- (2) The evaluation of academic profile (coefficient 2) is based on:
- results of the GCE 'O' Level or *Probatoire*;
 - results of the GCE 'A' Level or *Baccalauréat*;
 - the number of times one repeats a class or the public examination;
- (3) The written examination is made up of multiple-choice questions and shall comprise:
- A one-hour paper in biology, coefficient 2;
 - A one-hour paper in chemistry, coefficient 1;
 - A one-hour paper in physics, coefficient 1;
 - A one-hour paper in general knowledge based on current events, coefficient 1.

ARTICLE 7:

Each subject is scored from zero to one hundred. Any score less than twenty in any written test disqualifies the candidate.

ARTICLE 8:

The program of the competitive examination is that of the scientific *Baccalauréat C* or *D* or the scientific GCE 'A' Level in the subjects: Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

ARTICLE 9:

- (1) The deliberations are carried out by a jury appointed by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education following the proposition of the Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré.
- (2) The final results are published through a press release by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education.

ARTICLE 10:

The admission cannot be postponed from a year to another.

ARTICLE 11:

The expenditures linked to the organization of the competitive examination are imputable to the 2022 budget of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundéré.

ARTICLE 12:

The Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré, the Director of University Accreditation and Quality and the Dean of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundéré are responsible, each in his/her sphere of competence, for the implementation of this Decision which will be registered and published wherever necessary/.
