Lunch a competitive entrance examination **into the first year of Master** of the Biomedical and Health Science Programs for **the Ebolowa** site of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundere, for the 2021/2022 academic year.

open, in regularisation, Biomedical and Medical-Health courses at the  
Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundéré  
Mindful of the resolution n° 08/CAE/31/07/2019 of the 2nd extraordinary session  
of the Board of Governors of the University of Ngaoundéré giving a favourable  
opinion for the opening of the annex of the Faculty of Science of the University of  
Ngaoundéré in Ebolowa  
Following the proposal of the Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré,

**DECIDE:**

**Article 1 :**

A competitive examination for the recruitment in the first year of the Master cycle in the fields of Clinical Biology, Radiology and Medical Imaging and Operating Room Assistant in the Department of Biomedical Sciences of the Faculty of Sciences (FS) of the University of Ngaoundéré is open on **Sunday 16 January 2022** for the academic year 2021/2022.

**Article 2 :**

(1) The competition shall be open in one session only to Cameroonians of both sexes who hold a Bachelor's degree in Biomedical or Medical Sciences or a diploma recognised as equivalent by the Minister of Higher Education.

(2) Candidates who are nationals of member countries of the Economic and Monetary Community of Central Africa (CEMAC) having ratified the texts relating to the national treatment of students and justifying the required qualifications are admitted to compose under the same conditions as their Cameroonian counterparts.

**Article 3 :**

The annual tuition fees for this training are 50,000 (fifty thousand) CFA francs for candidates from the CEMAC zone admitted by competition.

**Article 4 :**

Candidates will compose in the **Yaoundé and Ebolowa** centres.

**Article 5 :**

The number of places is fixed at ninety (90) and distributed as follows:

**Article 6**

The complete application files must reach the Service de la Scolarité of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundéré, the UN Branch in Yaoundé (Fouda district), "Lycée Classique et Moderne" of Ebolowa, before **January 10, 2022**. They should include the following documents:

- a) A handwritten application stamped at the prescribed rate,
- b) A registration form available on the MINESUP website: [www.minesup.gov.cm](http://www.minesup.gov.cm), at the office of admission and record of the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Ngaoundéré, at the Branch of the UN of Yaoundé (Fouda district) and at "Lycée Classique et Moderne d'Ebolowa" ;
- c) A certified copy of the birth certificate, not more than three months old;
- d) A certified copy of the diplomas giving access to the Master's cycle,
- e) Five 4 X 4 identity photos (write the name on the back),
- f) A medical certificate issued by the doctor of the CMS of the University of Ngaoundéré or by a doctor of the administration, attesting that the person concerned is fit to pursue higher studies in health sciences,
- g) Transcripts of grades from the level(s) of the bachelor's degree (professional) cycle
- g) Transcripts of records for the level(s) of the bachelor (professional) cycle;
- h) A receipt of payment of the sum of 30,000 (Thirty thousand) CFA Francs for registration fees to the competition at "Société Générale Cameroun" to account n° 10003 00900 22091073445 19 FS Ngaoundéré;
- i) two 28 x 37 envelopes stamped with the applicant's address.

*NB: Candidates who have submitted their application subject to the Degree will be asked to present proof of admission to the said degree if they are admitted to the competition.*

**Article 7 :**

Under no circumstances are registration fees refundable.

**Article 8:**

Only candidates submitting a complete file will be allowed to compete.



**Article 9 :**

- 1) The examination consists of written tests (coefficient 4) and a case study (coefficient 1). The written tests cover the following subjects
- A speciality test (coefficient 3, i.e. 60% of the final mark, duration 2 hours).
  - A general knowledge test (coefficient 1, i.e. 20% of the final mark, duration 1 hour).
- (2) The general knowledge test covers current affairs and the history of medicine;
- (3) The programme for the speciality test is that of the Degree cycle;
- 4) The study of the file (coefficient 1) is established according to the candidate's university curriculum.

**Article 10:**

- (1) The deliberations are carried out by a jury appointed by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education following the proposition of the Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré.
- (2) The final results are published through a press release by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education.

**Article 11:**

The admission cannot be postponed from a year to another.

**Article 12:**

The expenditures linked to the organization of the competitive examination are imputable to the 2022 budget of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundéré.

**Article 13:**

The Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré, the Director of University Accreditation and Quality and the Dean of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundéré are responsible, each in his/her sphere of competence, for the implementation of this Decision which will be registered and published wherever necessary/.
