Launching the competitive entrance examination into **Year One, First Cycle** of the Higher Teacher Training College of the University of Bertoua, and defining the number of places opened for the **2022/2023** academic year.

- Mindful of Decree N°2012/433 of 1st 2012 October organising the Ministry of Higher Education;
- Mindful of Decree N°2018/005 of 08th January 2018 creating the Higher Teacher Training College, Bertoua;
- Mindful of Decree N°2018/190 of 2nd March 2018 completing certain dispositions of Decree N° 2011/408 of 9th December organising the government;

- Mindful of Circular N°004/CAB/PM of 10 February 2000 concerning admission into national training institutions and recruitment into the Public Service;
- Mindful of Order N° 220001/MINESUP/SG/DDES/DAG/DAJ of 4th February 2022 laying down the transitional modalities for the functioning of academic structures of the Universities of Bertoua, Ebolowa, and Garoua previously attached to other State Universities;
- Mindful of Order N° 18220053/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 10th March 2022 setting up the calendar for competitive entrance examinations into the institutions of Cameroonian State Universities and Schools under the Academic Tutelage of MINESUP, for the 2022/2023 academic year;

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: A written competitive entrance examination for the recruitment of student-teachers of General Secondary Education into Year One of the First Cycle of the Higher Teacher Training College of the University of Bertoua, for the 2022-2023 academic year, has been launched in the following series:

Article 2: (1) The examination shall be organised in one session and is open to Cameroonians of both sexes, **aged 29 years at most as of January 1st, 2022**, and holders of the “Baccalauréat” or GCE A/L that matches the desired series.

The series “Bilingual Letters” in the Higher Teacher Training College of Bertoua is open exclusively to holders of the GCE A/L and the ‘Baccalauréats A4 and ABI,’ fulfilling the other required criteria.

For candidates of the Anglo-Saxon subsystem of education, the series “Bilingual Letters” is open to holders of the GCE A/L in at least two subjects, including **French**, and at least four papers in the GCE O/L, including French, obtained in one session. The subject “Religious Studies” is not taken into consideration.

(2) The table below specifies the type of “Baccalaureat” and the main subjects a candidate must pass in the GCE A/L to be eligible to register in a given series:

Article 3: (1) Foreign candidates may be allowed to sit for the examination, under the same academic conditions and according to the number of places available, in conformity with the regulations in force.

(2) Candidates who are civil servants shall not write the competitive entrance examination as external candidates.

(3) Fraudulent admission that precludes the appropriate certificate, grade, age or seniority shall expose the candidate concerned to instant dismissal at any moment without any formal procedure.

Article 4: The application files shall comprise the following documents:

- A registration form to be filled in online and printed out available at the ENS Bertoua website on the following link: <https://concours.ens-univ-bta.com>;
- A certified photocopy of the birth certificate of not more than three (3) months old from the date of issue;



- Certified photocopies of the Probatoire or GCE O/L and Baccalaureat or GCE A/L transcripts;
- A certified photocopy of the Baccalaureat or GCE A/L or a certificate recognized as equivalent by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education, which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue, or a certified photocopy of result slips of Baccalaureat or GCE A/L;
- A medical certificate issued by a medical officer of the Public Administration, testifying that the candidate is physically and medically fit for teaching;
- A certificate of non-conviction which must not be more three (3) months old from the date of issue;
- A receipt of twenty thousand (20 000) FCFA as examination fee issued by **SCB Cameroon** account N° 10002 00076 90001425571 67

No other form of payment is accepted;

- One stamped A4 envelope, with the tariff in force, bearing the candidate's address;
- An authorisation to sit for the exam issued by the Minister of Basic Education, the Minister of Secondary Education or the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education, as the case might be, for candidates working in these Ministries.

Article 5: Holders of foreign diplomas shall submit either the equivalence or the receipt showing that they applied for the equivalent, delivered by the Ministry of Higher Education. The final admission of these candidates shall be confirmed only upon presentation, within the deadline set by the competent authorities, of the order in which the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education grants the solicited equivalence.

Article 6: All complete files must be submitted at the Head Office of the Higher Teacher Training College (HTTC) Bertoua (for the East Region), or at the Regional Delegations of MINESEC, latest on **October 07, 2022 latest at 3.30 pm..**

Article 7: The examination comprises two parts: a written part and the study of files.

- a. The written part (one major paper and one minor paper) which counts for 70% of the total assessment;
- b. The study of files which counts for 30% of the total assessment;
- c. No orals

The mark from the study of files shall be considered only at the end of the written part in the final mark.

Article 8: The written part will take place on **October 15, 2022** in the following examination centres: **Bafoussam (IUT-Fotso Victor de Bandjoun), Bamenda (Delegation of Secondary Education, Up-Station), Bertoua (ENS and Lycée Scientifique), Douala (IUT de Douala), Ebolowa (ENSET), Garoua (Lycée Classique et Moderne), Maroua (Collège de l'Espoir), Ngaoundéré (Lycée Classique et Moderne) and Yaoundé (ENS campus and University of Yaounde I).**



Article 9: The scheduling of papers per series is indicated in the following table:

The syllabuses of the competitive entrance examination in each section are the same as in the Baccalauréat or GCE A/L programmes for each series.

The grading of each written paper ranges from zero to twenty and is multiplied by the aforementioned coefficients. Any score below five on twenty (5/20) is eliminatory.

Article 10 The assessment of candidates' files will be based on:

- The relevance of the candidate's profile
- The candidate's age;
- The number of years spent in secondary education,
- Marks scored in the "Probatoire" or GCE O/L and in the "Baccalauréat" or GCE A/L

Article 11: After the written part, the jury shall prepare the list of successful candidates per series and by order of merit. Successful candidates cannot, under any circumstance, postpone their registration from one academic year to another.

The final results shall be published by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education.

Article 12: The composition of the jury mentioned in Article 11 above shall be specified in a special order by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education.

Article 13: The entrance examination fees mentioned in Article 4 above are non-refundable.

Article 14: The Rector of the University of Bertoua, the Director of the Department of University Accreditations and Quality of the Ministry of Higher Education, and the Director of the Higher Teacher Training College, Bertoua, are responsible, each in his/her own capacity, for the implementation of this order which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever need be.
