DECISION No. 18720789 MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 7⁵ JUNE 2022

To launch a competitive entrance examination into **the first year of Sciences and Technics of Biological Agriculture Programs** of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundéré, for the 2022/2023 academic year.

- Mindful of Decree no. 2011/410 of 09 December 2011, to appoint members of government;
- Mindful of Decree no. 2012/333 of 29 June 2012, to appoint a Vice-Chancellor and Rectors in some State Universities;
- Mindful of Decree no. 2012/433 of 01 October 2012, to organize the Ministry of Higher Education;
- Mindful of Decree no. 2017/318 of 27 June 2017, to appoint staff to posts of responsibility in State Universities;
- Mindful of Decree no. 2020/231 of 22 April 2020, to appoint staff to posts of responsibility in State Universities;
- Mindful of Order no. 21-00767/MINESUP of 13th December 2021, to create the Sciences and Technics of Biological Agriculture programs, in the Faculty of Science of The University of Ngaoundere;

Mindful of Order no. 18220053/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC du 16 march 2022, to fix the calendar of competitive entrance examinations into the Faculties, Schools and Institutions of State Universities, for the 2022/2023 academic year.

Following the proposition of the Rector of The University of Ngaoundéré,

HEREBY DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1:

A competitive entrance examination for the admission of **40 (forty)** students into **the first year of the Sciences and Technics of Biological Agriculture programs** of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundéré is opened on **Sunday 04 September 2022** for the 2022/2023 academic year. Candidates will sit for exam in **Yaoundé, Ngaoundéré, Maroua, Garoua and Douala**.

The places offered are distributed as follows:

Candidates for the 1st year entrance examination must not be more than **twenty-five (25) years old** on **1st January 2023**.

ARTICLE 2:

(1) The competitive entrance examination is opened to Cameroonians of both sexes, holders of *Baccalauréat série C, D* and TIC or the General Certificate of Education Examination, Advanced level (GCE 'A' Level) in at least three science subjects and GCE 'O' level, or any other equivalent certificate recognized by the Minister of Higher Education. The subject "Religious Knowledge" is not considered.

(2) Members of the Central African Economic and Monetary Community (CEMAC) who have ratified the text concerning the national treatment of students will also be admitted under the same conditions like those of Cameroonians.

(3) Members from non CEMAC countries just like members from CEMAC countries who do not want to write the competitive entrance examination could be admitted on the study of files,

depending on the availability of places, if they are beneficiaries of scholarships from their governments or an international organization, committed to pay the higher tuition fee related to their status.

ARTICLE 3:

The complete application files must reach the Admission and Records Office of the Faculty of Science, University of Ngaoundéré or at the antennae of University of Ngaoundéré, Yaoundé (Fouda district), at the Admission and Records Office of the Faculty of Science of the University of Maroua, at the Admission and Records Office of the Faculty of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences of the University of Garoua, at Admission and Records Office of the ENS of the University of Bertoua or at the Admission and Records Office of the Faculty of Science of the University of Douala, not later than **02 September 2022**, and shall comprise the following documents:

1. A registration form, available on the MINESUP website: www.minesup.gov.cm, the Admission and Records Office of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundéré, at the Admission and Records Office of the Faculty of Science of the University of Maroua, at the Admission and Records Office of the Faculty of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences of the University of Garoua, at Admission and Records Office of the ENS of the University of Bertoua or at the Admission and Records Office of the Faculty of Science of the University of Douala;
2. A receipt of payment of the sum of 20.000 (twenty thousand) CFA Francs for registration fees to the competition at “Société Générale Cameroun” to account n° **10003-00900-22091073445-19 FS** Ngaoundéré;
3. Certified photocopies of the scientific Baccalaureate or a scientific GCE/AL certificate or any certified proof of success to one of these examinations;
4. Certified photocopies of the scientific GCE ‘A’ level or scientific *Baccalaureate* and GCE ‘O’ level or *Probatoire scientifique* transcripts;
5. A certified photocopy of birth certificate of not more than 03 months old;
6. A medical report of physical and mental fitness, testifying that the candidate is apt for higher education studies, issued by a medical doctor of the public administration;
7. Five passport-size photographs 4x4, with the names of the candidate at the back;
8. An appropriately stamped A4 envelop with the personal address of the candidate.

NB: Candidates can submit their application subject to the Baccalaureate or the GCE A/Level.

ARTICLE 4:

The registration fees are nonrefundable.



ARTICLE 5:

Only candidates with complete application files would be allowed to compete for admission into the study programs.

ARTICLE 6:

(1) The competitive examination is made up of:

- evaluation of academic profile (coefficient 2, thus 30% of the total mark)
- written examination (coefficient 5, thus 70% of the total mark)

(2) The evaluation of academic profile (coefficient 2) is based on:

- results of the GCE 'O' Level or *Probatoire*;
- results of the GCE 'A' Level or *Baccalauréat*;
- the number of times one repeats a class or the public examination;

(3) The written examination is made up of multiple choice questions and shall comprise:

- a one hour paper in biology, coefficient 2;
- a one hour paper in chemistry, coefficient 1;
- a one hour paper in physics, coefficient 1;
- a one hour paper in general knowledge based on current events, coefficient 1.

ARTICLE 7:

Each subject is scored from zero to one hundred. Any score less than twenty in any written test disqualifies the candidate.

ARTICLE 8:

The program of the competitive examination is that of the scientific *Baccalauréat C* or *D* or the GCE 'A' Level in the subjects: Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

ARTICLE 9:

(1) The deliberations are carried out by a jury appointed by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education following the proposition of the Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré.

(2) The final results are published through a press release by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education.

ARTICLE 10:

The admission cannot be postponed from a year to another.



ARTICLE 11:

The expenditures linked to the organization of the competitive examination are imputable to the 2022 budget of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundéré.

ARTICLE 12:

The Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality and the Dean of the Faculty of Science of the University of Ngaoundéré are responsible, each in his/her sphere of competence, for the implementation of this Decision which will be registered and published wherever necessary/.
