To launch the competitive entrance examination into the 4th year of the Master of Engineering of the National Advanced School of Engineering of the University of Maroua, and to fix the number of places available for the 2019-2020 academic year.

Mindful of law n° 005 of 16 April 2001 to set up Higher Education orientation;
Mindful of decree n° 2011/408 of 09 December 2011 to organize the Government;
Mindful of decree n° 2011/410 of 09 December 2011 to appoint members of Government;
Mindful of decree n° 2019/002 of 04 January 2019 to appoint members of Government;
Mindful of decree n° 2008/280 of 09 August 2008 creating the University of Maroua;
Mindful of decree n° 93/027 of 19 January 1993 fixing common dispositions in state Universities, modified and completed by the decree n° 2005/342 of 10 September 2005;
Mindful of decree n° 2008/281 of 09 August 2008 on the administrative and academic organization of the University of Maroua;
Mindful of decree n° 2008/458 of 29 December 2008 appointing the Rector of the University of Maroua;
Mindful of decree n° 2012/433 of 01 October 2012 on the organization of the Ministry of Higher Education;
Mindful of decree n° 2017/318 of 27 June 2017 appointing a Vice-Chancellor and Rectors in some State Universities;
Mindful of decree n° 2017/350 of 06 July 2017 bringing a change of name of Higher Institute of the Sahel to national advanced school of engineering of Maroua;
Mindful of decree n° 2018/074 appointing officials in state universities;
Mindful of Mindful of order n° 00054/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC/SE of 27 February 2019 to organize the calendar of competitive entrance examinations into Faculties, Schools and Institutes of Cameroon State Universities for 2019-2020 academic year;

On the proposal of the Rector of the University of Maroua;

ORDERS :

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination for the admission of two hundred and ten (210) students engineers into the 4th year of the Master of engineering of the National Advanced School of Engineering of the University of Maroua for the 2019-2020 academic year.

Article 2 :

(1) The examination shall be organized in one sitting for Cameroonians holders of the Bachelor of Science Degree or Diploma required for each course applied for, or of the Bachelor of Sciences passed in at least two subjects including the major subject of the series, the subject "Religious Knowledge" is not taken into consideration.

(2) The table below shows the required, Bachelor of Engineering, Bachelor of Sciences required to be qualified to register for the competitive entrance examination:

Article 3:

(1) professionnals or workers who are successful in the competitive examination must pay a fee for their training.

(2) Foreign candidates proposed for the training by their government are admitted under the same academic conditions as above depending on the number of places available.

Article 4: The application files shall comprise the following documents:

- A printed application form duly filled in by the candidate on the websites : www.minesup.gov.cm or <http://www.univ-maroua.cm> or <http://www.enspm.univ-maroua.cm>.
- A certified photocopy of the national identity card;
- A certified photocopy of the birth certificate dated not more than three (03) months;
- Transcripts of levels I, II, and III of Bachelor's Degree signed or certified by the competent academic authorities;
- A certified photocopy of the baccalaureate or GCE /AL, or any other diploma recognized equivalent by the Minister of Higher Education, dated not more than three (03) months;
- A certified photocopy of the Bachelor's degree or Bachelor of engineering, or any other diploma recognized equivalent by the Minister of Higher Education, dated not more than three (03) months and gave the right to the competition;
- A medical certificate is issued by-a medical officer from the Administration testifying that the candidate is physically and medically fit for teaching;
- An extract from the criminal record (bulletin n ° 3) dated not more than three (03) months;
- An original receipt Express Union upon payment of twenty thousand (20,000) CFA as registration fee delivered. Competition fees are not refundable;
- An A4 envelope stamped at 400 FCFA and addressed to the candidate;

- Four (04) passport-size photographs (4x4);
- Working Candidates should attest their experiences in the field;
- An authorization to sit for the examination from of the Heads of Ministerial Departments for civil servants candidates.

Article 5: Holders of foreign diplomas shall submit either the equivalence or the receipt showing that they have applied for the equivalence of their diplomas or certificates issued by the Minister of Higher Education. However, their final admission and the award of a diploma or attestation of completion at the end of their training may be acquired only upon presentation within the time limits set by the competent authority, of the text granting equivalence to their diploma, and obtained from the Minister of Higher Education by the candidate.

Article 6: The Completed application file should be submitted either to the Regional Delegations of the Secondary Education, or to the National Advanced School of Engineering of the University of Maroua, or to the Department of Meteorology, Climatology, Hydrology and Pedology of the Advanced School of Engineering in Kousseri or to the Antenna of the University of Maroua in Yaoundé, on or before **12 September 2019 at 3,30 p.m. precisely.**

Article 7: The competition shall comprise:

- Three written test accounting for 70%
- A scholar appreciation accounting for 30%

Article 8: The written papers will take place on **15 September 2019**, in the following examination centers: Douala, Dschang, Garoua, Kousseri, Maroua, Ngaoundéré and Yaoundé.

Article 9: The written test are divided as follows:

The programs of the competition are those of the Bachelor's degree of Sciences, Bachelor of Engineering of the corresponding specialty, will be published by the University of Maroua.

At the end of the written tests and after the registration in the school records, the jury shall publish the list of successful candidates. There is no oral examination.

Admission cannot be deferred for the next or any other academic year.

Article 10: Scholar appreciation is determined according:

- to the age of the candidate;

- the number of years to obtain the Bachelor's degree of Sciences, Bachelor of Engineering;
- Transcripts of Year I, II, and III Bachelor's degree of Sciences, Bachelor of Engineering;
