Launching competitive examination in the first year and direct admission in the second year into the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies (SUP'PTIC) of Yaounde, and the Regional Training Centre of Buea, for the 2022-2023 academic year.

- Mindful of decree N°2012/433 of 1<sup>st</sup> April 2012 organising the Ministry of Higher Education;
- Mindful of decree N° 2016/425 of 26<sup>th</sup> October 2016 changing the denomination and reorganizing the National Advanced School of Posts and Telecommunications;
- Mindful of decree n°2017/594 of 04<sup>th</sup> December 2017 appointing the Director and the deputy Director of the National advanced School of the Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies;
- Mindful of decree N°2019/002 of 04<sup>th</sup> January 2019 to reshuffle the Government;
- Mindful of order N°000057/MPT/ENSPT/CD of 11<sup>th</sup> November 1993 fixing the special duties into the National Advanced School of Posts and telecommunications;
- Mindful of order N° 18220053/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 16<sup>th</sup> Mars 2022, organizing the calendar of competitive entrance examinations into Faculties, Schools and institutions of Cameroon State Universities for 2022-2023 academic year;  
On the proposal of the Director of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies.

**DECIDE:**

**ARTICLE 1:** Competitive entrance examinations for admission into the different training cycles of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies (SUP'PTIC) of Yaounde and the Regional Training Centre of Buea shall be written on the 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> of August 2022 at all Regional headquarters: Bafoussam, Bamenda, Bertoua, Buea, Douala, Ebolowa, Garoua, Maroua, Ngaoundere and Yaounde.

**ARTICLE 2: GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR WRITING**

**1- For Assistant Telecommunications Engineers (ATE)/Bachelor in Engineering**

- Should be male or female, aged 15 years at least as from the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022;
- Should be a holder of the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level" certificate in at least two science subjects, Mathematics and Physics, A' level technical GCE or any equivalent certificate.

**2- For Inspectors of Posts and Telecommunications (IPT) / Bachelor in Administration**

- Should be male or female, aged 15 years at least as from the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022;
- Should be a holder of the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level" in at least two subjects or any recognised equivalent certificate.

**3- For Telecommunications Technicians (TT)**

- Should be male or female, aged 15 years at least as from the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022;
- Should be a holder of the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level" certificate in at least two science subjects, Mathematics and Physics, "Advanced Level" technical GCE or any equivalent certificate.

**4- For Controllers of Posts and Telecommunications (CPT)**

- Should be male or female, aged 15 years at least as from the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022;
- Should be a holder of the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level" certificate in at least two subjects or any equivalent certificate.

**ARTICLE 3: NUMBER OF PLACES AVAILABLE**

Candidate's file which must be submitted at SUP'PTIC Yaounde, Regional Training Centre of Buea or all Posts and Telecommunications Regional Delegations except Yaounde and Buea on the **12<sup>th</sup> August 2022** for the national and the foreigners candidates latest, shall be made up of the following documents:

- An application form to be collected from all the Regional Delegations of Posts and telecommunications except Yaounde and Buea, the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies of Yaounde, the Regional Training Centre of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies of Buea or in the school webside [www.e-supptic.cm](http://www.e-supptic.cm);
- A payment receipt of **15,000 F CFA**, in any Post office to accountant of SUP'PTIC (Account number **150657330-19**);
- A certified true copy of birth certificate not more than 03 Months old from the date of certification;
- A certified true copy of the required certificate;
- A school attendance certificate for candidates still expecting the results of the required certificate;
- A medical certificate of fitness for working in the Posts and telecommunications sector, issued by a public medical practitioner;
- Two (02) passport size photographs (4x4);
- A certified true copy of the National Identity card;
- A self-addressed stamped envelope (**500 FCFA** Postal Stamp).

**ARTICLE 8:** Candidates are requested to come to the examination centres at least 30 minutes before the start of each examination paper. They must come along with their national identity card and receipt of submission.

**ARTICLE 9:** Admission in the second year of Assistant Telecommunications Engineers and Posts and Telecommunications Inspectors cycles is granted for candidates' holders of:

- For the cycle of Assistant Telecommunications Engineers, Diploma of Telecommunications Technician of SUP'PTIC or DEUG, BTS, DSEP, DUT, HND, HDD in Telecommunications, Electronics, Electrotechnics and Computer sciences or any recognised equivalent certificate;
- For the cycle of Posts and Telecommunications Inspectors, Diploma of Posts and Telecommunication Controllers of SUP'PTIC or HND, DEUG in Economics, Management, Law science, Logistics and Transport or any recognised equivalent certificate.

**ARTICLE 10:** Examination registration fees are non-refundable.

**ARTICLE 11:** Only candidates who have submitted a complete and regular file shall be authorised to sit for the examinations.

**ARTICLE 12:** The results of the examinations shall be published by a communique of the Minister of Higher Education and the Minister of Posts and Telecommunications.

**ARTICLE 13:** Foreign students shall sit for special tests organised by the Director of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies.

**ARTICLE 14:** At the end of their training, the best students will be admitted directly in the master program.

**ARTICLE 15:** The Director of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies and the Director for University Accreditations and Quality are each in his capacity, responsible for the implementation of this decision, which shall be registered, published and broadcast wherever need be./-
